We are delighted to update you on the progress of our Primary 2 students throughout Term 3. This term has been full of enriching experiences and engaging lessons that have helped our students grow both academically and personally.





International Mother Language Day

During our Science classes, our students studied about living organisms and their habitat. They learned about the different habitats in which living organisms can be found and the roles they play in the ecosystem.

2D and 3D shapes, counting in money, and measuring mass were our topics in Mathematics. Students were able to co-relate and describe 2D shapes with 3D shapes. Our students were also introduced to counting and making change using money, helping them to develop real-world problem-solving skills. They learned how to measure weight using a weighing machine and the use of different units of measurement.

Story Writing improved significantly with grammatically correct sentences. The students learned to identify and use different parts of speech to create effective sentences. They were able to apply this knowledge into their Story Writing, developing more complex sentences, making their stories more interesting.

Outside of the classroom, our students have had the opportunity to participate in a range of cultural and artistic activities. We celebrated Pohela Falgun, International Mother Language Day, and Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's Birthday, which gave our students the chance to learn about and appreciate their heritage. Additionally, as part of the Art Festival, our students visited Courtside Clay Station to learn how to make beautiful pottery with clay. The final day of the Art Festival week was filled with excitement as all SSK students participated in various Art workshops, including different types of paintings, Rickshaw Art, Clay Station, and Calligraphy.
