5 Steps to Sun Safety

In summer (or any other season) protecting kids from the sun’s Harmful rays is a must. The following are tips from the American Academy of Dermatology and the American Academy of Pediatrics:

- Limit outdoor playtime between 10a.m. and 4p.m. try to avoid exposure when the sun's rays are at their strongest. Even On cloudy or cooler days, ultraviolet (UV) rays remain strong.
- Apply sunscreen properly. Generously apply sunscreen 20-30 minutes before your child goes out in the sun. Choose a sunscreen with SPF (Sun Protection Factor) 15 or higher. Reapply sunscreen every 2 to 3 hours, or after sweating or swimming.
- Cover up. Wearing protective clothing and hats is one of the most important ways of warding off UV damage. And don't forget the accessories: sunglasses with UV protection to guard against burned corneas, and hats to prevent sunburned scalps and faces and carry a large umbrella.
- Keep watch on medications. Some medications increase the skin's sensitivity to the sun, so make sure to ask your doctor whether your child may be at risk.
- Set a good example for your kids. If your child sees you following sun-safety rules, he'll take them for granted and follow suit.

Dear Parents,

Winter bids its long goodbye and the spring is here with all its color. With advent of this festivity of nature we are going to start term – 4. We have had a really busy time during Term-3 with a number of different cultural events and classroom activities. It has been a wonderful time as we have had so much to talk about. Throughout the Term the children explored countries of the world where we are living in, as our theme was “*Countries of the World*”. We have introduced the topic with the song “*Asia, Europe..... Don't forget Australia*”. Through different activities we have traveled different countries of the world like India, Thailand, China, Australia, Egypt, USA and many more. Now they are aware about the National/traditional costumes, music, dance and cuisine specific to different countries. The children have enjoyed playing “ I know These Countries name” in a small group. Group games are an excellent way for the children to develop their social and communicative skills in a fun way that also strengthens their relationships with each other.

At the end of Term 3, the children are confident enough to solve number bonds. However, they also got the concept of addition, subtraction and their operation signs as well. Furthermore they are also able to tell the timing in the clock by the hour and half past. In language and literacy, children are performing extremely well. It was nice to hear from some of you that children are guiding you to read a word phonetically. We have been practicing visual perception, word recognition and extended vocabulary as they are finding given words in the puzzle or searching for hidden words within words. We can see the joy of accomplishment when they recognize the high frequency words everywhere around them.

Our smart thinkers are now know about the concept sink and float, day and night, rain and shine, animals as pets, animals and their young etc. They learned about certain domestic animals that can be kept at home as pets. They were engaged in different activities as they learned the ways in which pets have to be taken care of. They were surprised to know how pets need a warm, safe, and sheltered place to live, to ensure adequate food, water and when sick need to be taken to the vet. During lesson time kids showed their excitement and they could relate the topic as most of them have pets of their own. They were also amazed to know different ways in which animals take care of their babies.

After the successful completion of term -3 the caring children are optimistically entered to Term - 4. It had been an exciting experience working with Children this term too.

Throughout the term we used various teaching methods to implement our new theme "**connecting with the world**" where children gained knowledge about the world geography and different culture. The most interesting part of the theme was that the children got the opportunity to identify the lifestyle in extreme environment such as Arctic area and Dessert area by using World Map.

They had the opportunity to use the different hands-on materials to practice their language and literacy skills. Now they are able to speak fluently with clear punctuation using the model sentence "I was born in _____, I am _____."

The most exhilarating activities were in Logical Thinking lesson. We have observed that children can confidently tell the time by the hour and half past from the clock in the classroom after getting the concept of Clock Time.

. They also demonstrated an understanding of place values of tens/ones in addition and subtractions.

Along with the classroom activities, caring family performed on the occasion of International Mother Language Day; our children greeted the audience using different languages also. During, Art festival, the students of K2 got the opportunity to learn the techniques of sewing from the preschool Principal Ms Israt. It was an extra fun for Caring children and I am sure each of the embroidery they done was unique.

This term also we have focused on Bangla language and our aim is to help them learn how to arrange words in a form of a sentence, to recite poems and to read Bangla story books with correct pronunciation. We are glad that they are enjoying Bangla rhymes ছড়ায় ছড়ায় সংখ্যা helped them to learn and reinforce the name of Bengali numbers effortlessly.

In kinder fit, we did some fun activities such as travelling stations, where they moved around on different body part in a confident manner. Our young children become aware of the key points of body balance and jumping which improves locomotor skills and coordination of muscles.

With all these marvelous activities we ended term 3 and we started Term - 4. Thereby, we are looking forward to another term of fun and learning.
